



Whereas an Agreement for the Commutation of Tithes in the Township of Guerdon in the Parish of Leyland in the County of Lancaster was, on the twelfth Day of April in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty eight, confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners of England and Wales, of which Agreement with the Schedule thereunto annexed the following is a Copy.

Articles of Agreement for the Commutation of the Tithes of the Township of Guerdon in the Parish of Leyland in the County of Lancaster in pursuance of the Act for the Commutation of Tithes in England and Wales made and executed at a Meeting duly called and holden in the said Township and adjourned from time to time and holden by adjournment on the sixteenth day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty eight. By and Between The Several Tenants Owners of Lands within the said Township by whom or by whose Agents duly authorized in that behalf these Presents are executed and the interest of which Land (rights in the Lands of the said Township is not less than two thirds of the Lands therein subject to tithes of the great Tithes of the said Township and Robert Townley Parker of Guerdon and of Keyte both in the said County being Owner of two undivided third parts or shares of the said great Tithes of the said Township and Jane Susanna Houghton of Ashey Hall in the said County being Owner of the remaining one undivided third part or share of the said great Tithes of the second part and Mr. Herbert Gardner Baldwyn Vicar of Leyland in the said County Clerk and as such Vicar the Owner of the small tithes Arable Lands and Pasture Offerings of and within the same Township of the third part in witness whereof these Presents witnessed that at the said meeting it hath been and is mutually agreed upon That the annual sum of Twenty nine pounds twelve shillings and four pence by way of Rent Charge subject to the Provisions of the said Act shall be payable and paid to the said Robert Townley Parker and Jane Susanna Houghton their heirs and assigns in the proportions following that is to say The sum of Nineteen pounds seventeen shillings and eleven pence to the said Robert Townley Parker his heirs or assigns and the sum of Nine pounds seven shillings and four pence to the said Jane Susanna Houghton her heirs or assigns instead of all the great Tithes of the Lands of the said Township and instead of all tithes Medietate prescriptive or customary Payments payable in lieu thereof And that the annual sum of Fifty five pounds by way of Rent Charge subject to the Provisions of the said Act shall be payable and paid to the said Gardner Baldwyn as such Vicar and his successors instead of all Vicarial or small Tithes Medietate prescriptive and Tithes of and within the said Township and instead of all Easter Offerings Claims and Demands payable by all persons whomsoever now residing or to be hereafter coming to words within the said Township. All summary Description of Lands of which Township is contained in the Schedule hereafter written And it is further agreed that the lands included in this Agreement shall be discharged from the payment of Tithes from the first day of January next before the expiration of the apperishment of the rent Charge herebefore agreed upon and the first payment of such rent Charge shall be made to be recoverable on or to the expiration of six calendar months from the time from which the said lands are discharged from the payment of Tithes.

In testimony whereof the said parties to these presents or their respective Agents duly authorized in their names and on their behalf have hereunto their hands subscribed and set their respective hands and seals

Schedule to the above Articles of Agreement.

- The whole Township of Guerdon contains by estimation Four hundred and ten acres one rood and nine perches of land customary measure.
- The whole quantity of Lands of the said Township which are subject to the payment of any kind of Tithes is by estimation Three hundred and sixty seven acres and nine perches customary measure.
- The whole quantity of Land subject to Tithes within the said Township which is cultivated as tillable Land is by estimation sixty two acres and three roods customary measure.
- The whole quantity of Land subject to Tithes within the said Township cultivated as meadow or pasture land is by estimation Three hundred and four acres one rood and nine perches customary measure.
- There is within the said Township by estimation the thirty eight acres customary measure of ancient Woodland and Plantations.
- There is within the said Township by estimation five acres and one rood customary measure of land covered by messes of buildings and by water and occupied by Highways and Roads.
- There are not any medietate compositions real or customary payments payable instead of any of the Tithes arising from the lands within the said Township and except a medietate composition real or customary payment of twelve shillings in lieu of all Vicarial Tithes Tithes and Easter Offerings issuing and payable out of the demesne lands called Guerdon Hall.
- None of the lands of the said Township are or have been under any circumstances exempt from the payment of Tithes except as aforesaid.
